Functional Tips for Print Envoy



This month's tip for getting more from your Print Envoy implementation!

New Feature: Print Envoy Archive Log Cleanup -By Olivia Johnson <u>Olivia.Johnson@cloudinventory.com</u>

In this month's issue of Print Envoy Functional Tips, we will take a closer look at logging and archiving maintenance in Print Envoy, introduce you to some new features, and give you the tools and knowledge you need to best manage your Print Envoy printing logs and record archive.

Every time you print a label in Print Envoy, a log entry appears in Print Log Inquiry. From the Print Log Inquiry form, you can check the Log Details of the label data file, or reprint the label with the same data the file contained at the original time of printing. If you print a lot of labels (and we hope you do!) then you likely will end up with more records than you need in the Print Log Inquiry table. Print Envoy configuration allows us to either Archive or Delete records once your Max Log Rows value is reached. See below.

- Archive Print Log: Determines whether excess records are archived to DSI_EPP_ArchivePrintLog or deleted.
- Max Print Log Rows: Determines max number of rows allowed in Print Log Inquiry. Once the limit is reached, oldest records will be Archived or Deleted.

Cleaning Up Print Envoy Archive

If you have Archive Print Log set to Y, then old records will accumulate in DSI_EPP_ArchivePrintLog table. We have added a new feature to Print Envoy which allows you to manage your Archive, either manually or in the background via Microsoft Dynamics 365 Batch Processing framework.

Navigate to DSI Print Envoy > Periodic > Purge Print Log Archive.

The current status of your Print Log Archive table will appear at the top. In our environment, the Print Log Archive is empty. Under Parameters, enter the number of days you want to keep in the Archive. If you enter 7, all records from the most recent 7 days in the Print Archive will remain, and any records that are older than seven days from the newest archived record will be deleted.

You can enable Batch Processing as well, to automatically clear out archived records in the background. Enter your Task Description, assign a batch group, modify Recurrence and Alerts settings. You will then be able to see the batch job status and details in System Administration > Inquiries > Batch Jobs.

I hope this new Archive cleanup tool and overview of Print Envoy's archive configuration will help you to streamline your label printing, reduce bloat, and only keep what you need.
