Print Envoy New Feature Preview: Loftware Web API

In this month's issue of Print Envoy functional tips, we are introducing a new feature: Integration between Print Envoy in D365 and the Loftware Cloud label printing engine solution. Up until now, Print Envoy has been primarily used to integrate with on-prem label


printing engine instances via Print Courier Service. Moving forward, customers will be able to continue using Print Envoy with Print Courier to drop label files into a monitored drop folder and will alternatively be able to use Print Envoy to print via Cloud. If you are already a Loftware customer and are considering moving to the cloud, this new feature is for you. Coming soon, we will be introducing BarTender Cloud integration as well!

Configuring Loftware Web API


Integration with Loftware's web API is simple: After you have registered your User/API Key on Loftware Cloud, navigate to DSI Print Envoy > Print Server Drop Folders.

The link to Loftware Cloud is configured using 4 fields,

- 1. Drop Folder Name The name you want to give the drop folder. It is only referenced in Print Envoy.
- 2. Drop Folder Enter the URL of the Loftware Cloud end point.
- 3. Label Server Type select Loftware. Print Envoy knows if you want to create a text based drop file or use a web link.
- 4. User / API Key enter the API key tied to your Loftware Cloud account. Select the "Validate API" button to check the URL and API Key values. If successful, the API version is returned. If unsuccessful, an error message is displayed.




Print Envoy will display error messages if you run into issues validating your connection information. Shown below are a few sample cases and their associated errors. If the URL entered in the Drop Folder column is incorrect, we should see an error while sending the request. If the User/API Key is incorrect or invalid, we should see an error indicating our access is denied due to an invalid subscription key.




Configuring Printers

The link to Loftware Cloud allows Print Envoy to dynamically pull a list of available printers.

You can assign a known Loftware Cloud printer to your Print Envoy Printer entry using the API Printer Name drop down column, and the printer's Workstation Id will populate automatically in the next column. Then, you can create your printer selection rules the same way you are used to.



When a handler is fired and the printer and template rules are evaluated, Print Envoy displays a confirmation message when a print request has been made.



If there is an error with the print request, Print Envoy displays the error message returned by the Loftware Cloud processor.

*Note: Loftware Cloud requires that the label fields included in your data file to match your label template's expected inputs exactly. If any extra fields are present or any fields are missing, the print request will be rejected.
